

The EYFS Statutory Framework states that early year's settings must provide children with resources and materials to meet the basic requirements in the Statutory Framework, in relation to children's learning, development and care. As a setting, we have always provided additional resources to enhance children's learning, in relation to their likes and interests.

The following is a non-exhaustive list of resources and materials which would be considered over and above the basic EYFS provision and which will be covered by the price you pay for the enhanced provision: - - - - -

Art and Craft resources such as; extensive variety of art supplies including coloured paper, coloured card, tissue paper, a variety of paint sets, a variety of colouring materials (wax crayons, gel pens, etc.), sequins, feathers, other decorative items, pom-poms, pipe cleaners, shaving foam, googly eyes, clay, play-dough, play-dough cutters, painting sponges, stickers.

Sensory resources such as; water beads, corn flour, frozen objects, moon sand, rice, pasta, shaving foam, saw dust, shaving gel, fabric pieces.

Nature based resources such as; compost, outdoor chalk, outdoor buckets and spades, loose parts resources, tarpaulin. Compost, soil, seeds. Outdoor chalk.

Special events and celebrations resources such as; party decorations, speciality craft materials in relation to events such as Christmas crafts, Easter crafts, Mother's day and Father's day crafts. Disposable tableware. Additional food related cleaning materials- dish soap, sponges, waste disposal specific to meal service and baking activities.

Miscellaneous and Administration resources such as; printer ink, printer paper, laminating pouches, plastic wallets, sticky notes, sticky labels, display boards, display backing paper, display boarders. Registration forms, settling in sessions and continual administration throughout your child's time with us.

Learning and educational resources such as; whiteboard markers, whiteboards, clipboards, chalkboards, flashcards, visual cues, magnifying glasses, educational games. Flash cards & cue games, educational games and task sheets.

Loose parts- corks, bottle caps, buttons for heuristic play

Cleaning supplies for an enhanced clean, beyond the requirements, such as; antibacterial surface spray for non-standard cleaning, air fresheners, disposable cleaning cloths, nappy sacks. Laundered sheets for sleeping (where applicable)

Food tasting and sampling, baking, parental events and parent evenings.

First Aid – Instant ice packs, cold compress packs (for non-emergency use). Extra disposable gloves for non-statutory procedures, Specialist safety equipment – finger guards, corner protectors.
